Throughout its history, the agency has provided quality care to young people. As the needs of our society changed, Beacon Light Behavioral Health Systems evolved into a private, not-for-profit social service agency providing quality, professional behavioral health and educational services to young people.

Beacon Light Behavioral Health Systems' continuum of care includes residential treatment (RTF), treatment foster care (TFC), emergency shelter placement, partial hospitalization programs, alternative education, day treatment, treatment for sexually aggressive youth, outpatient therapy, and residential services for the mentally retarded/developmentally disabled (Ramsbottom Center). Qualified mental health treatment professionals provide individualized treatment planning and care for the children and adolescents served by the agency.

Available Placement Options

Traditional Residential Treatment (RTF) - Beacon Light operates three JCAHO accredited facilities, including a 48-bed community based RTF in Bradford, PA, as well as 16-bed facilities in Youngsville, PA and 8-beds in Towanda, PA. Each facility provides treatment in a caring environment focused on help and healing. Nurturing is balanced with responsibility and personal accountability on the part of residents. Twenty-four hour, awake supervision and a client-to-staff ratio of 4:1 allow for consistent supervision.

1st Street Residential Treatment Center (RTC) - This setting is ideal for the first stages of treatment for sexually aggressive youth. The facility features delay-lock, alarmed doors, 24-hour video surveillance, and around-the-clock, awake supervision. All staff members have received advanced training in dealing with the complex issues associated with this population. Residents receive individual and group counseling from a team of Master's level clinicians. Additionally, the 1st Street RTC provides the opportunity for on-going observation and assessment by the treatment team.

Regional Placement Alternatives - Beacon Light offers multiple regional placement options to better serve clients from across the Commonwealth. With locations in Bradford, PA (McKean County), Youngsville, PA (Warren County), and Towanda, PA (Bradford County), clients are able to receive quality mental health and behavioral treatment within a reasonable distance of their home community. This allows for improved communication with placing agencies, as well as more involvement with the caretaker.
