Throughout its history, the agency has provided quality care to young people. As the needs of our society changed, Beacon Light Behavioral Health Systems evolved into a private, not-for-profit social service agency providing quality, professional behavioral health and educational services to young people.

Beacon Light Behavioral Health Systems' continuum of care includes residential treatment (RTF), treatment foster care (TFC), emergency shelter placement, partial hospitalization programs, alternative education, day treatment, treatment for sexually aggressive youth, outpatient therapy, and residential services for the mentally retarded/developmentally disabled (Ramsbottom Center). Qualified mental health treatment professionals provide individualized treatment planning and care for the children and adolescents served by the agency.

## Wraparound Services

## Wraparound Services

The idea behind wraparound is to "wrap" services around a child and family, enabling the child to function at home, school, and in the community, while avoiding the need for out-of-home placement. Wraparound is used when more traditional forms of services, such as Outpatient Therapy, have proven unsuccessful in meeting the child's needs.

Children and young people up to the age of 21 years are eligible for wraparound services. The individual must have a mental health diagnosis with a psychologist's or psychiatrist's recommendation for wraparound services.

All referrals must go through the CASSP (Child and Adolescent Service System Program) process of interagency team collaboration for the purpose of ensuring that the child's and family's needs are best being met.

Parents, teachers, physicians, therapists, or school personnel can make a referral for wraparound directly to Beacon Light.

If wraparound services are recommended and the parents and child are willing to receive services, the child and parents may choose Beacon Light Behavioral Health Systems as their wraparound provider.

Wraparound services from Beacon Light Behavioral Health Systems are available in McKean, Elk, Cameron, Warren, and Forest counties. For more information, contact the nearest Beacon Light office.
