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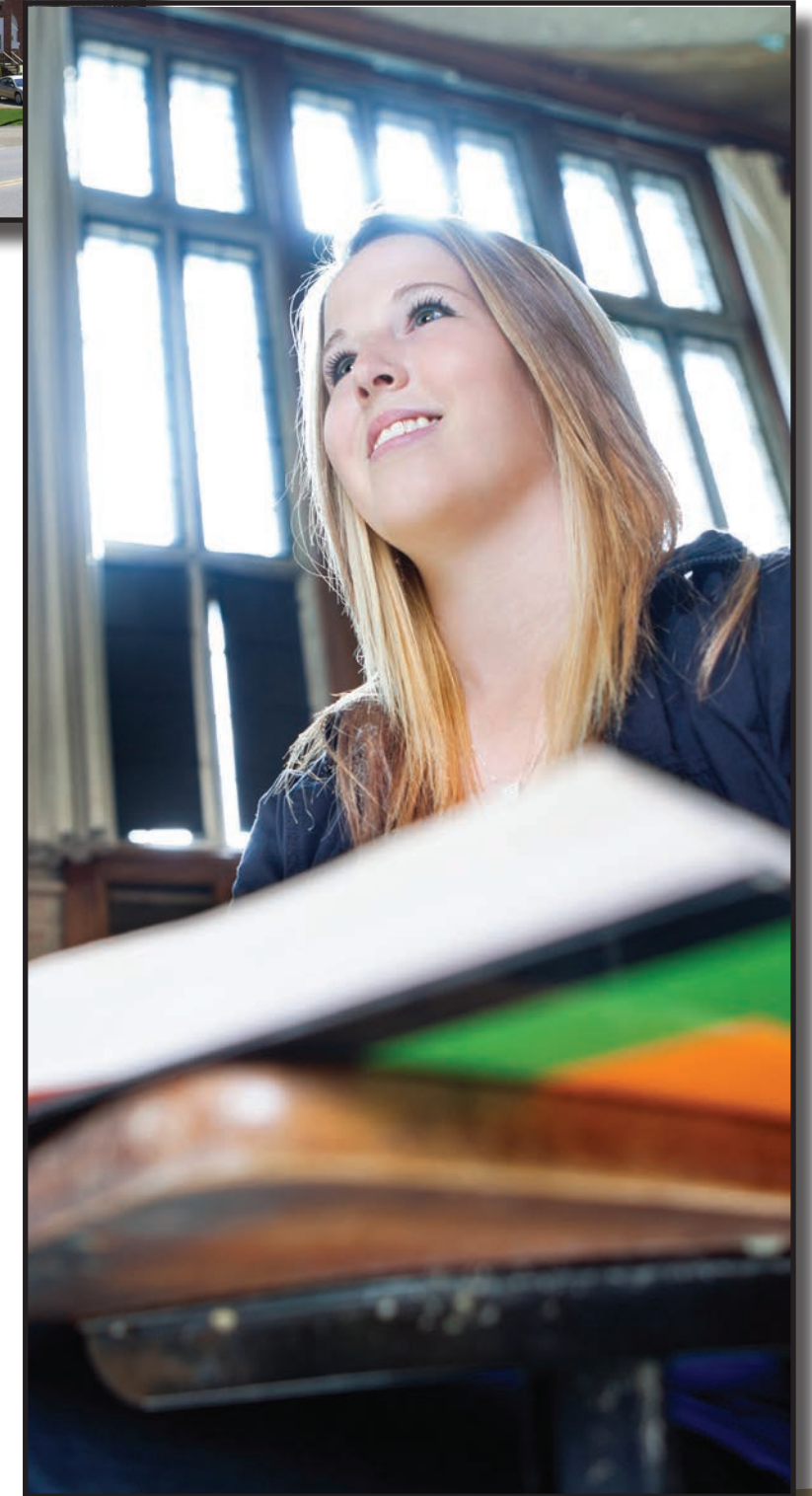


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Program Description

The Custer City Private School (CCPS) is a licensed private academic school serving students that require special education services. It currently serves students in grades 3-12 with disabilities in the areas of Autism/PDD, Learning Disabled, Intellectually Disabled and Emotionally Disturbed. Classrooms are broken down into six groups: emotional support middle grades 6-8, emotional support secondary grades 9-10 and 10-12, learning support secondary grades 9-12, autistic support grades 7-12 and life skills support grades 7-12.

The private licensed program can serve up to 58 students.

Pennsylvania certified teachers provide instruction in all core content areas.

A teacher and support staff are present during all classes to assist with classroom management.

Referral Process

For students to attend CCPS, they need to be referred by an administrator in their current school district. Administrators interested in referring students to CCPS need to contact the Coordinator of Education. Program availability and questions regarding reason for referral will be discussed to determine if CCPS can meet the student's needs.
